COURSE OF STUDY

The curriculum includes English language and literature, Bengali, History, Geography, Mathematics, Computer Application, Students Volunteers, Environmental Science, Fine Arts, Music etc. Computer subject compulsory from Class STD-II to STD-V.

DAILY ROUTINE

Our school starts with prayer which is held daily in the morning at 10.40 a.m. Prayer Schedule consists of Slokas from Scriptures, Meditation, reciting Ananda Vaniis, taking oath etc.

After prayer academic classes covering English, Bengali, Mathematics, History, Geography, Science etc. are taught.

Apart from traditional subject, meticulous care is taken to stress moral lessons through Stu-Vol (students volunteers programme). Stu-Vol and play way method make the learn environment quite joyful and enjoyable.

The stu-vol lessons containing P.T, Parade, Games etc. are given special attention helping the students to develop service spirits, leadership qualities and other values of life.

We have our own transport system to collect boys and girls from different corners of our locality. It consists of many auto vehicles and Bus. The transportation fee is collected monthly.

CONCEPT, EDUCATION & SCHOOL MEANS

Ananda Marga Pracharaka Samgha is a religious and charitable society duly registered on the 9th day March, 1964, under West Bengal Societies Registration Act. XXVI of 1961 vide Registration No.- S/6086 of 1963-64 having its Global Quarters at 527 VIP Nagar, Eastern Metropolitan Bypass, Tiljala Kolkata - 100.

It is also relevant to mention here that the said 'ANANDA MARGA' besides being a registered society has also been held by the supreme Court of India, 'A religious denomination' under article 26 of Constitution of India. (Vide AIR - 1985 SC 51).

In our locality is a co-educational English medium (neo-humanistic based) runs under the supervision of Education Relief and Welfare Section (ERAWS) of Ananda Marga Pracharaka Samgha. Children of all sects, castes and creed are admitted.

MANAGEMENT

The School is managed by Education Relief and Welfare Section (ERAWS) of the aforesaid Annanda Marga Pracharaka Samgha through its structural supervisory workers as Mentioned in rule - 27 of the Guidelines of A.C. (Advisory Committee).

OFFICE HOURS

The principal / Teacher-in-charge is available from : 10.30 A.M. to 2.30 P.M. (During day school) by pre-arranged appointments.

The Office remain closed on Sunday and other public holidays.

SESSION

The Academic Session of the institute being from the month of January every year.

GENERAL REGULATION

1. Students must attend the school regularly and punctually. Parents and guardians are requested to ensure the same.
2. Parents/guardians are requested to see their wards devote sufficient time at home to prepare the assigned home task. Attending to the regular home-task is given due consideration at the time of annual promotion.
3. Any kind of damage done to school property will have to be compensated either individually or collectively.
4. If any student does not mend his/her behaviour, he/she shall be discharged from the school.
5. Pupils suffering from contagious or infectious diseases shall not be permitted to attend the school.
6. School dues are to be paid on the notified date.
7. Parents/guardians are not permitted to see the teacher/students in their classroom. They should contact the Principal/Teacher-in-charge directly for information and help.
8. Friends and acquaintances are not permitted to meet the students in the school campus.
9. No pupil shall be eligible for promotion to higher class unless he/she registers attendance of 75% of the total number of working days of the school in the whole year, curricular and co-curricular syllabus. Parents are particularly requested to take note of this rule.
10. Parents are welcome to visit the school and contact personally the Principal/Teacher-in-charge during the specified visiting hours to ascertain the progress of their children.
11. Parents are requested to go through the progress report issued to their children and cooperate with the school authorities in removing the defects, pointed out.

RULES FOR ADMISSION

The academic session starts from January. The application form and prospectus may be received from school office on payment of Rs. _____ during office hours.

Parents / guardians are required to fill the application form with utmost care. An admission test will be taken to candidates of classes from Nursery to Std. - V. The dates of admission test which will be held at school will be intimated to the candidate after the receipt of the application forms duly filled in. The students will be examined mainly in English, Bengali, Mathematics, Science and General Knowledge proficiency. The candidate from other school is admitted on the basis of their 'Transfer Certificate.' In case of first admission guardian's declaration of age supported by birth registration certificate or such other authentic document like Affidavit from a court is to be submitted. Those who are mentally and physically unfit will not be considered to be eligible for admission

HOLIDAYS

Our school remain closed on Sundays. Besides there are holidays subject to a maximum of 65 days in a year inclusive of two long vacations - one Summer and there during the festive days of Sarodotsav.

EDUCATIONAL TOUR

Besides the educational programmes inside the campus of our school, students in groups are sometimes taken on educational tours to different important places in and around West Bengal. Special attention is given to arrangements of food, health educational potentialities, convey-ance and stay in order to make the students non-monotonous, orderly and comfortable.

ANANDOTSAV

Birthday of national leader Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose, universal poet (Biswa Kabi) Rabindranath are celebrated with due solemnity. Days of national importance e.g. 23rd January, 26th January, 15th August etc. are observed with due honour. Teacher's day is observed every year.

In Teacher's day students of upper classes take classes of different lower classes. The students take part in this teaching practice are ranking to 1st, 2nd and 3rd according to their performances. They are also rewarded for encouragement.

STAFF

Our school staffs, both teaching and non teaching and school administration consist of dedicated and spiritually elevated persons coming form different sides. LIBRARY

There is a library containing many books of different sides in both languages - Bengali and English, Students subscribing their names there, can take the books to their homes. To take any book students will first entry their names and their selected books in the entry register with dates. They will have to return their books within ten days. A student can take one book only at a time.

RULES REGARDING FEES

Fee must be deposited within 10th of every month during the school time. The fees can be deposited after the end of month with a default fine of Rs. 50/- for every month. The fees of the months when long vacation such as summer vacation continues, shall have to be remitted before the school for the vacation.

Our school session starts from January. So anyone late admitted will have to pay the fees from the first session month, January.

REGARDING TIFFIN

The students will have to bring vegetarian tiffin with them daily. No student will come to school with fast food and junk food, Non-veg foods is strictly prohibited.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

For any absence prior leave application must be submitted to the Principal or Teacher-in-charge.

Pupil coming to attend the school after suffering from any contagious disease, must produce a medical certificate.

GENERAL RULES OF DISCIPLINE

1. All the boys and girls must come to school in prescribed uniform, otherwise they will not be allowed to attend their classes.
2. At the first bell, pupils must assemble for daily prayer.
3. Every student must feel that the property of the school is his / her own property.
4. Bringing of toys, crackers and things not required for study of craft, is not allowed in the school compound.
5. The school does not accept the responsibility for the loss of books, pen, copy-book, money, clothes and other things of the pupil.
6. No student will be allowed to go home during school hours, unless one brings a letter from one's parents / guardians.
7. Every student must maintain the high moral standard of the school by his / her manners and behaviors.
8. Students must be well-disciplined, well behaved and well mannered.
9. They must come to school in time with proper preparation of lessons.
10. Students should come in clean, full and well ironed school uniform.
11. They should come to school fifteen minutes before the prayer.
12. They should bring always prescribed text books and necessary exercise books in the class.

PRESCRIBED UNIFORM

All the pupils must come to school in prescribed uniform. Otherwise they will not be allowed to attend their class.

For Boys : Red shirt, Black shorts with school badge, tie, belt, black shoes and white socks.

For Girls : Red shirt with Black skirt, black shoes and white socks, school badge, tie.

Winter garments : Red coat or red sweater, Tie, Belt, Badge, School bag and winter garments are supplied from the school stores.

P.T. & Parade :

EXAMINATION AND RESULT DECLARATION
